Statement Regarding Tyco Security Compliance with Section 889 of the John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2019 and implementing regulations (the “NDAA”)

Section 889 of the John S. McCain National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2019 (the “NDAA”), restricts U.S. federal government agencies from purchasing, and, starting August 13, 2020, from contracting with companies that use, equipment, systems or services that use “covered telecommunications equipment and services” as “a substantial or essential component of any system, or as critical technology as part of any system”. Among the products and services expressly included within the definition of “covered telecommunications equipment and services” under Section 889 of the NDAA are: (i) telecommunications equipment and associated services produced by Huawei Technologies Company or ZTE Corporation (or any subsidiary or affiliate of such entities) and (ii) video surveillance and telecommunications equipment and associated services produced by Hytera Communications Corporation, Hangzhou Hikvision Digital Technology Company or Dahua Technology Company (or any subsidiary or affiliate of such entities).

Johnson Controls has reviewed the information in its possession regarding the currently available products (the “Current Products”) under the following Johnson Controls – Tyco Security product lines (the “Subject Product Lines”). The Current Products are comprised of the product part numbers available for purchase on Johnson Controls’ U.S. price list for the Subject Product Lines as of the date of this document.

- American Dynamics: Analog Cameras, DVR's, IP Cameras, IP Video Encoders, Matrix Switchers, Monitors, NVR's, Perimeter Solutions, Storage Solutions, Video Management Systems (victor), Video Analytics products
- Exacq: Series Servers- A, ELP, EM, G, LC, S, Z, Cameras, Gateways, Monitoring Stations
- Illustra: Pro, Flex, Essentials Gen4 Cameras
- Kantech: Controllers, Credentials, Exit Detectors, Intevo, ioProx Readers, ioSmart Readers, Locks, Telephone Entry Systems

As of the date of this document, no Current Products within the above listed Subject Product Lines constitute or include “covered telecommunications equipment and services” under Section 889 of the NDAA.
